When preparing the financial bid, you must adhere to the requirements of the specification of inputs as set out in the Terms of Reference. The tenders received will be subject to a technical assessment based on the CV and the concept in accordance with the annexed technical assessment grid. Only tenders that score at least 500 points in the technical assessment will be accepted for the financial evaluation. Technical bids that fail to reach this cut-off point will be regarded as unsuitable.

The technical bid is weighted at 70% and the financial bid at 30%.

If a consortium is to be formed for the service offered, please submit the consortial declaration.
